#### Bubble caterpillar

- Bottle with bottom cut off
- Terry cloth
- Elastic bands
- Bubble solution / water with washing up liquid with green colouring Cut the bottom of a bottle and secure a cloth over the bottom. Dip in bubble solution and blow through the top of

the bottle.





#### Bubble snake

- Bottle with bottom cut off
- Terry cloth
- Elastic bands

- Bucket of water
- Something that isn't fruit Drop each fruit into the water, splash! Drop something else that isn't fruit e.g. a car and say "oh, that's not fruit".

#### Tangerine drop

- Tangerines
- drum/tambourine
- glitter

- black tray or paper Sprinkle glitter onto tambourine. Drop tangerines onto tambourine from a height so glitter splashes everywhere.

#### Animal stencils
